This is to confirm that M/s. Capital Sports (Pvt.) Ltd., are a member of ILO-IPEC Programme on "Elimination Child Labour from Soccer Ball Industry Sialkot" since 29.10.97. They have transferred their 100% (one hundred percent) production of football stitching into the registered stitching centres which are regularly monitored by the International Labour Organization (ILO). During the period 01 April 1999-17 January 2000, the ILO monitoring teams have carried out 155 monitoring visits to the stitching centres of the Capital Sports (Pvt.) Ltd. In these monitoring visits the ILO monitors neither found any children at their centres nor any of their stitching work was found to be undertaken at un-registered centres. Based on its performance, the Capital Sports (Pvt.) Ltd. has been placed into Group "A"("Top"-List) on our performance classification list.
